What are main blocks in New Builder

- Static content is same as **Content Module** in legacy builder
 - To add a content block Navigate to Admin Panel → Event Setup → Build Website → Click on Edit Website → Click on Add Block on the top left of the screen → Static/Content Block → Click on the block type → Finally select the layout in which you wish to showcase the details of your content
- Each block and its element can be individually customized by clicking on the setting icon for that very element.

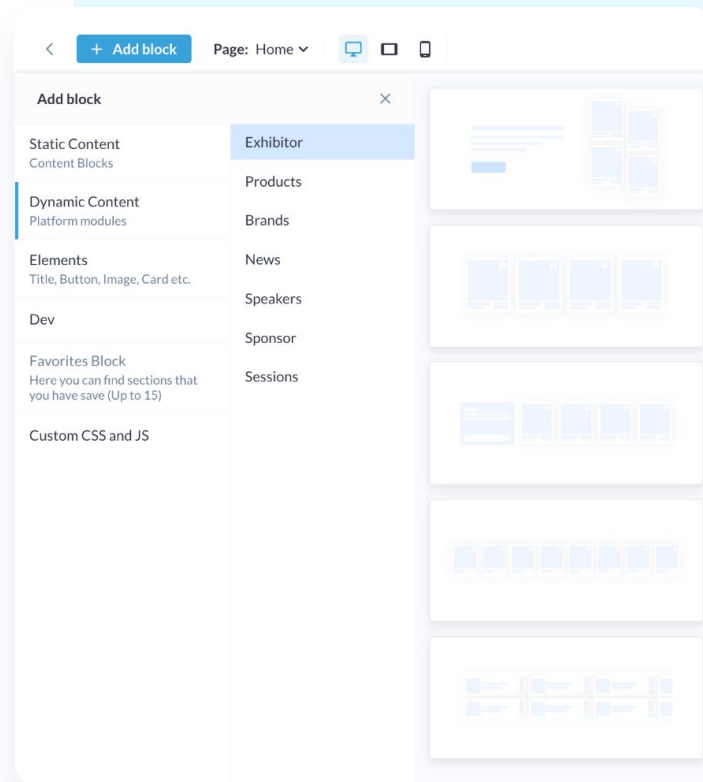

What are main blocks in New Builder

- Dynamic Content is same as **Platform Module** in legacy builder
 - Navigate to Admin Panel → Event Setup → Build Website → Click on Edit Website → Click on Add Block on the top left of the screen → Dynamic/Platform Block → Click on the block → Finally select the layout in which you wish to showcase

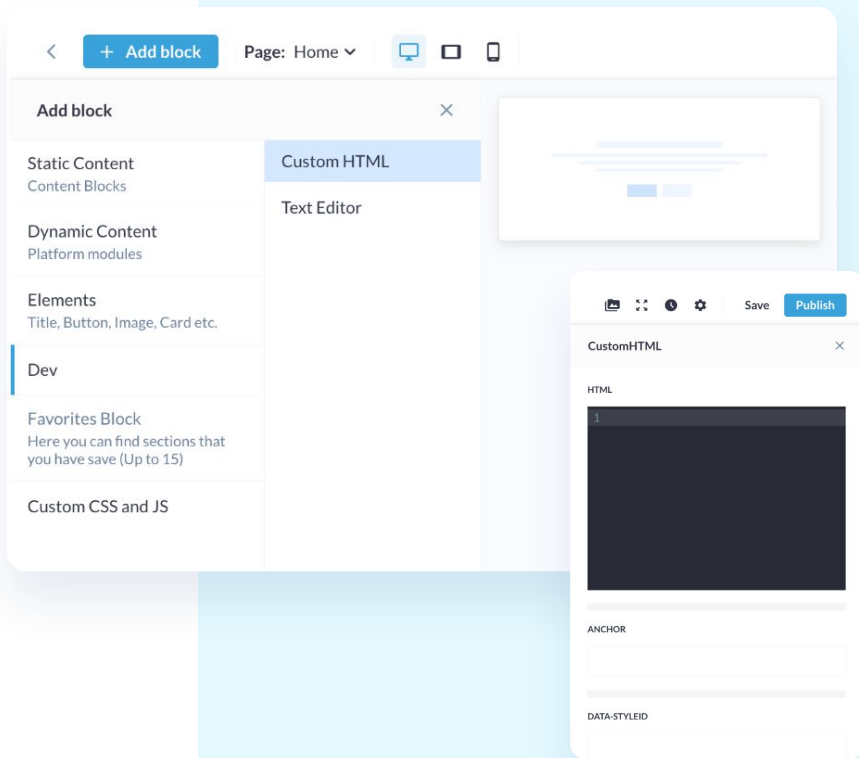

What are main blocks in New Builder

- **Custom Content Block** - The primary objective of integrating the Custom Content block into the New Website Builder is to provide users with a tool for creating highly customized and visually engaging web pages
 - Navigate to Admin Panel → Event Setup → Build Website → Click on Edit Website → Click on Add Block on the top left of the screen → Dev → Click on Custom HTML → Finally add the block and text and codes

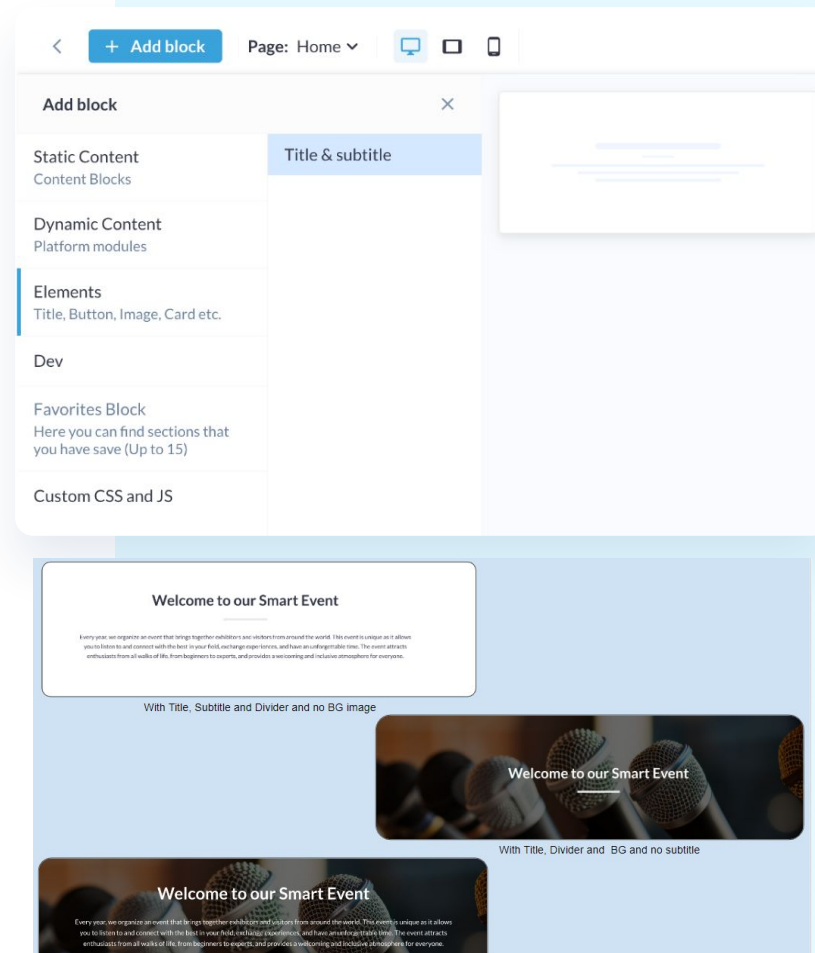

What are main blocks in New Builder

- **Element block** - For managing Titles and Subtitles, it is a predefined section or component that can be added to a webpage to enhance its functionality or design. They are designed to simplify the process of building a website by providing ready-made elements that can be easily inserted and configured according to the organisers' needs (with or without image)
- Navigate to Admin Panel → Event Setup → Build Website → Click on Edit Website → Click on Add Block on the top left of the screen → Elements → Click on Titles and Subtitles → Finally add the block

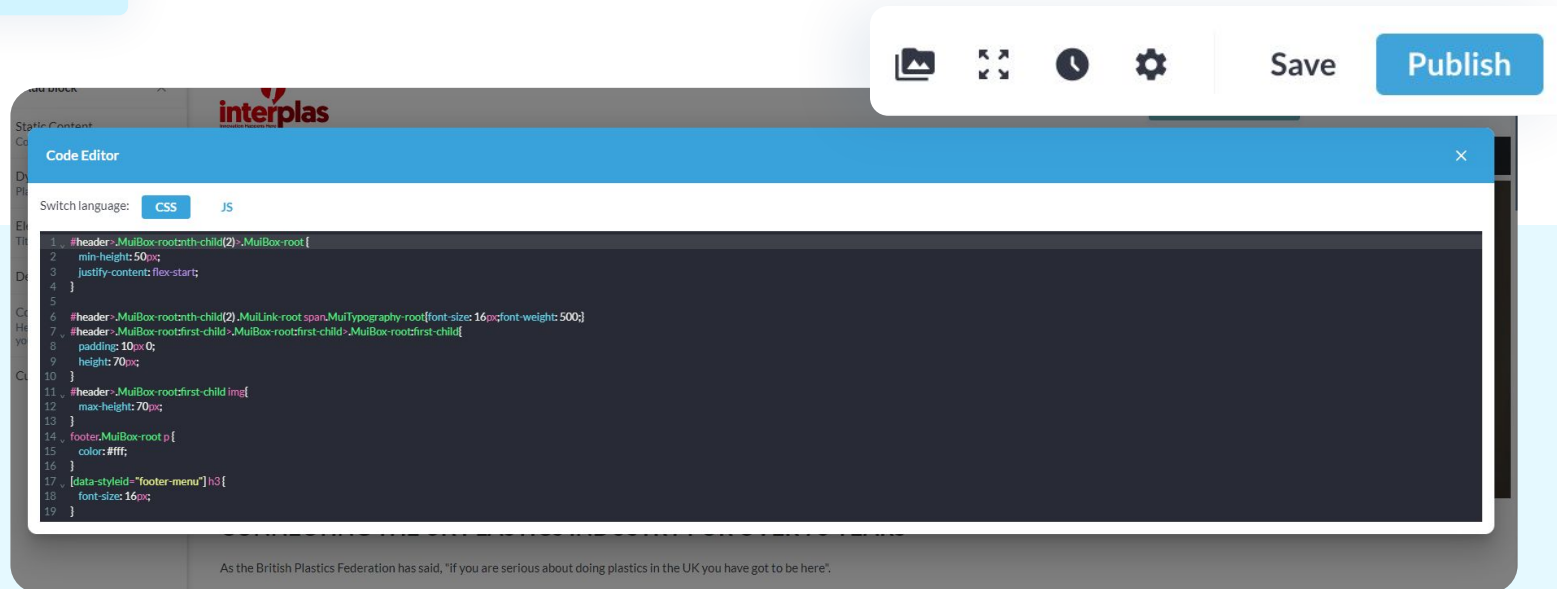

What are main blocks in New Builder

CSS/JS console helps to add custom styles or JS codes for websites same as legacy builder and you just need to save (no need to publish).



Things that customers/TAMs can do on their own in New Builder

1. Create multiple versions

Feature Use: It helps to create multiple versions, sometimes for testing purposes.

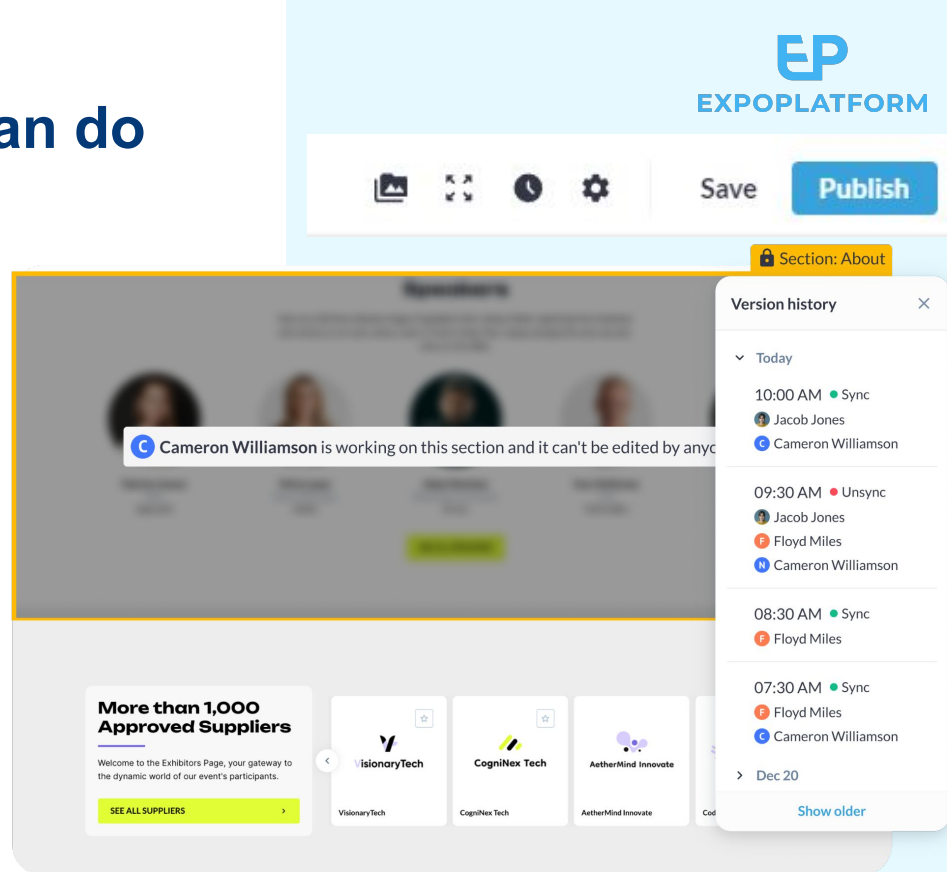

2. Version History

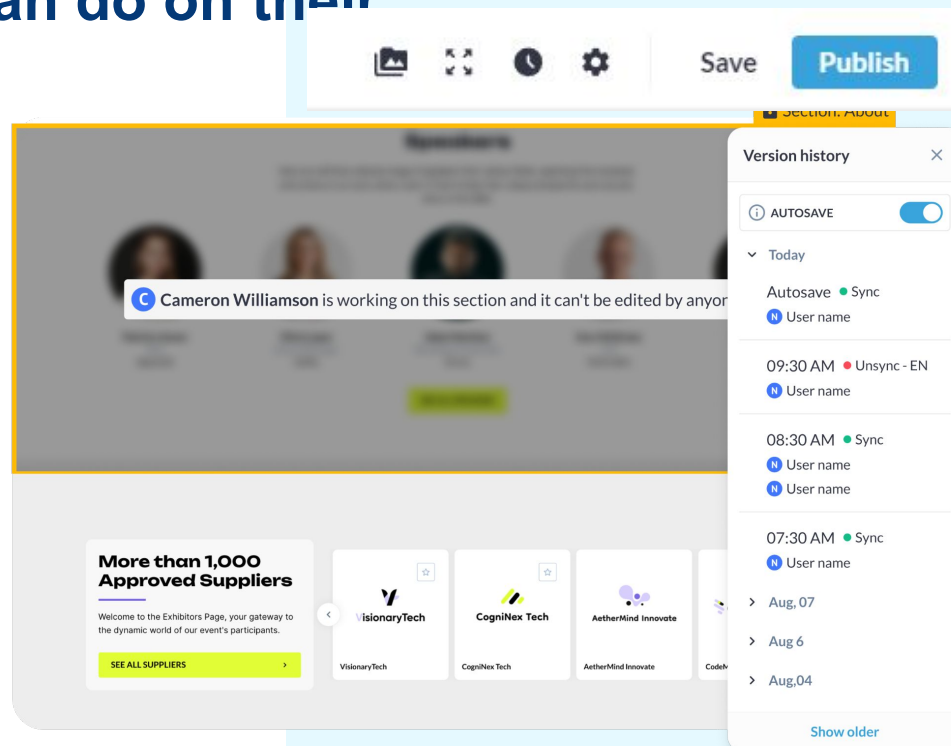
Feature Use: It will help to identify & restore any previous versions, in case something has changed by mistake.

3. Controlling Autosave

Feature Use: It will help clients to control the ability of web builder to automatically overwrite any changes when someone mistakenly stays in the builder.

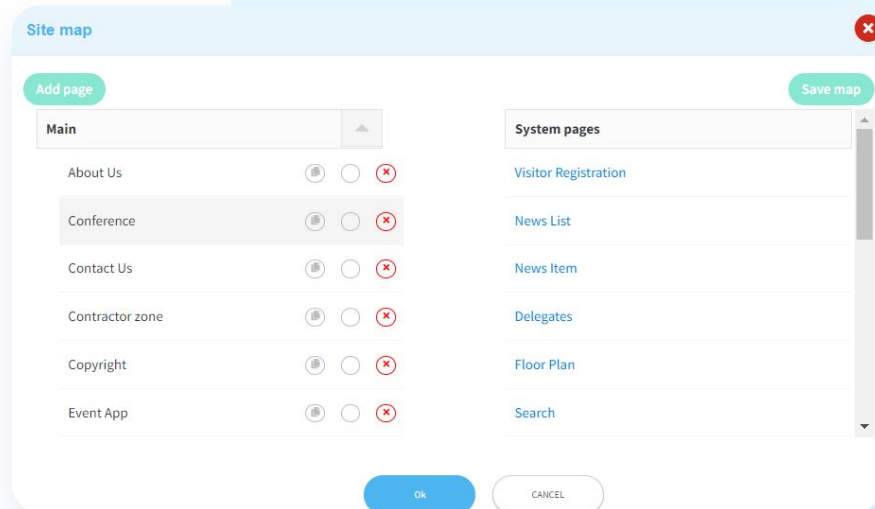

Things that customers/TAMs can do on their own in New Builder

5. Managing SEO

Feature Use : In case, client has cloned an event from a previous edition which used legacy builder, then the legacy builder pages would still exist in search engines. 3 Steps to be followed for managing SEO :

1. Before the launch, turn off the new builder from module management(don't worry you won't lose the work done in new builder)
2. Go to site pages, and delete the legacy pages
3. Switch the new builder back from module management



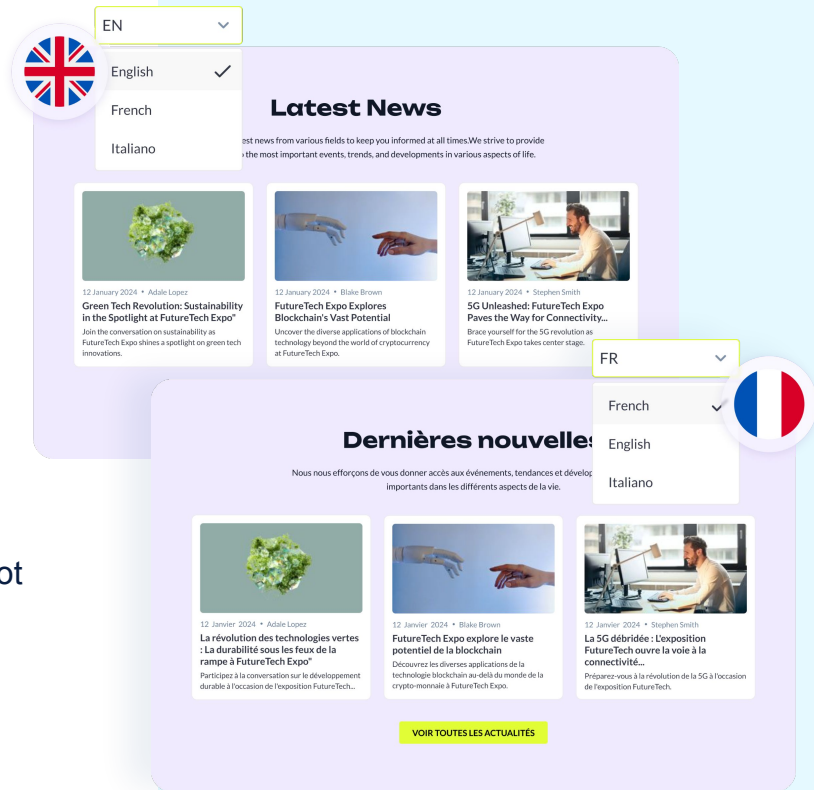
Things that customers/TAMs can do on their own in New Builder

6. Managing Multilingual website only in Sync Mode (Part 1)

Feature Use : By default, all content blocks are synchronized across all language variants, ensuring consistency in layout and structure. However, users have the flexibility to customize text elements independently for each language version, allowing for translation, font variations, styling, and the inclusion of hyperlinks.

1. All content blocks are synchronized by default, if there is certain content/blocks that organizer wants different per language that is not possible. (part 2)
2. Edits, additions, or removals of blocks automatically apply to all language versions

Modules missing in New Builder that were present in Legacy Builder

1. Cloning from Legacy Builder to New Builder

Feature Use in Legacy : Earlier in legacy builder, we could clone an entire website from previous edition to current edition by clone button

Where can you find this block? Legacy builder → Event>>Clone button

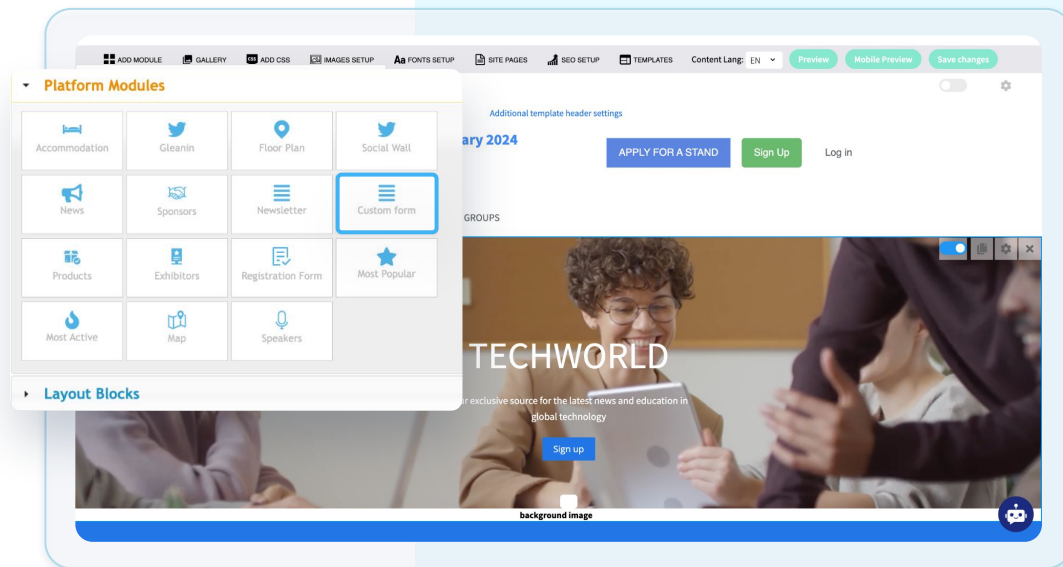
Modules missing in New Builder that were present in Legacy Builder

2. Custom Forms

Feature Use in Legacy : This section allowed the organizers to use custom forms in the website builder using the Custom Form block to capture additional information from the end users. The forms can be created under Marketing>>Forms and can be used across the website.

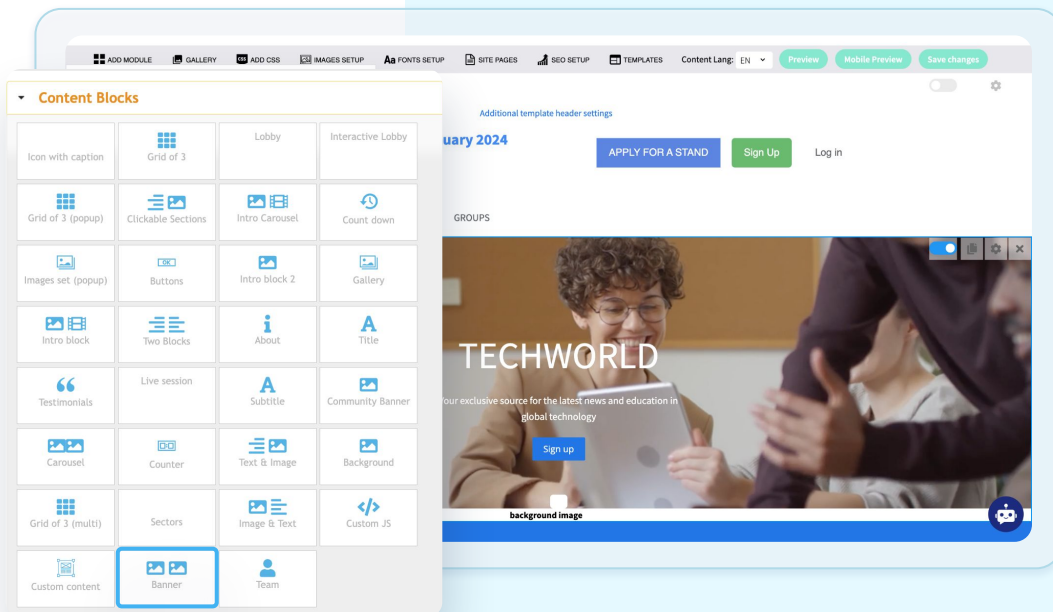
3. Adding Banners (Content Blocks)

Feature Use in Legacy : Clients were able to add multiple banners to custom pages, so that they can showcase different content and promotions to end users at set intervals.

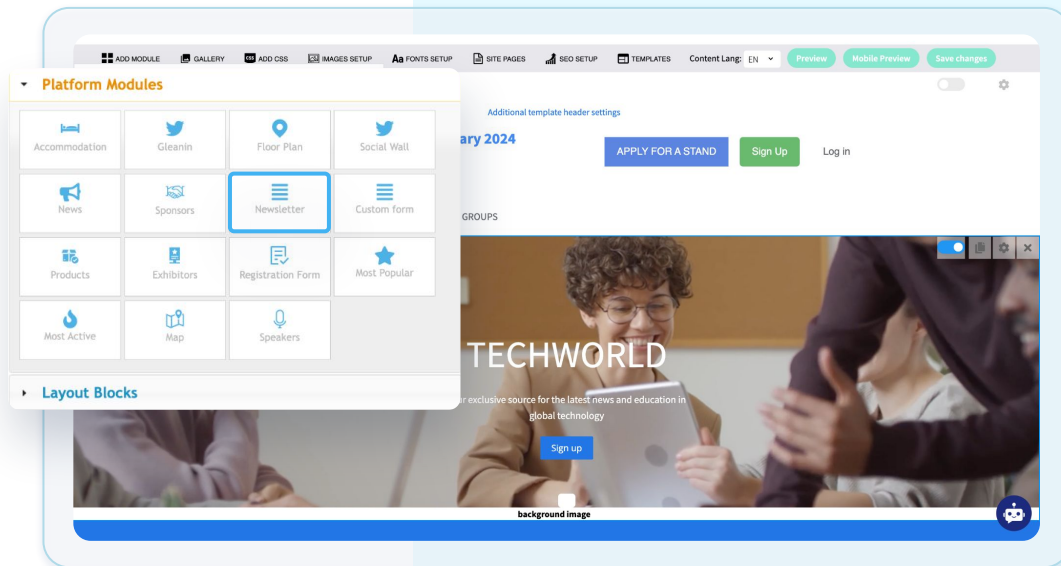

4. Newsletters

Feature Use in Legacy : Users were able to add their names, surnames and emails to subscribe to the newsletter from website

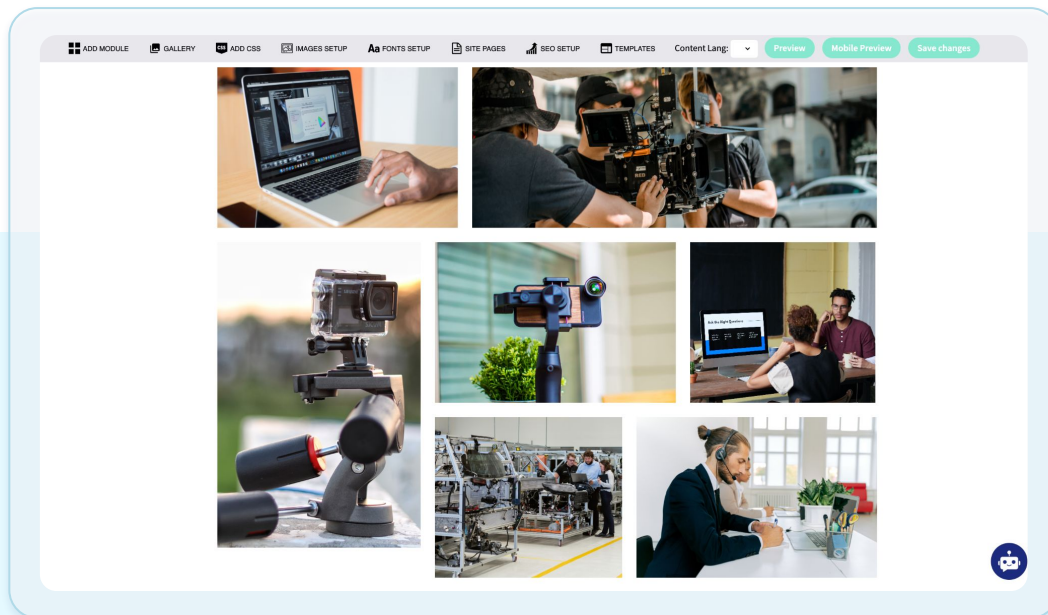

5. Images Asset dimensions

Feature Use in Legacy : Clients were able to crop the images while adding assets.

6. Mail to link in buttons block

Feature Use in Legacy : Clients were able to add direct “mail-to” link in a custom html block, so that users can just click on the “mail-to” link to directly email.

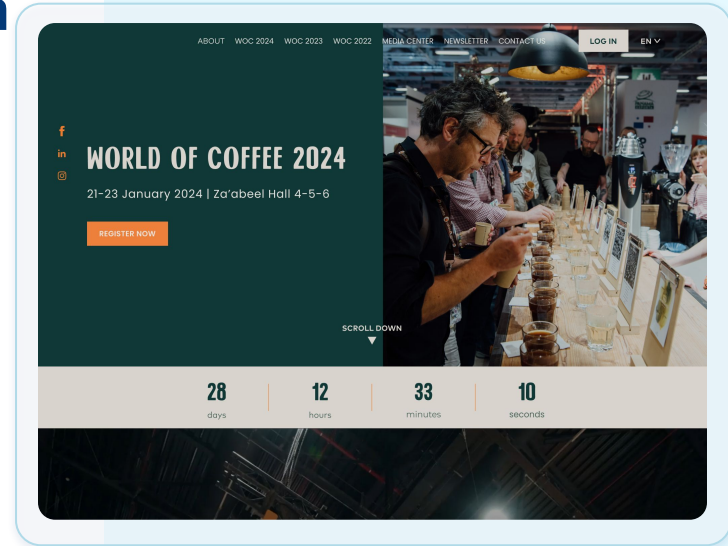

Guidelines for designing websites for customer

	Design services included when upgrade is purchased	Design services included with purchase of website builder
Initial creative design from our Design Team included?	YES	NO
Starting point for website	Design team using website builder + coding	TAMs (or client) using website builder to add blocks
When does Design Team review website?	During their design process	Once TAMs (or client) have built what they can with the website builder, Design Team will check colors and images, and will beautify the site
Limit on changes that are included	2 rounds of changes	Maximum of 3 hours of Design Team work per client website
